*The Emergency Placement Homes (EPH) are the second of a series of Sheshatshiu-based care facilities that will operate using the Innu Care Approach as a model of care and supported by a practice framework for operational guidance. The Coordinator of Clinical Services (CCS) will be a key member of the team and will be responsible for the design and implementation of clinical supports for children and youth at the Home. As other care facilities within the community begin operation, the CCS will expand the clinical support services to these other care homes.*

*Reporting to the Operations Manager, the CCS will primarily be responsible for providing clinical support to the EPH care teams. The CCS will assist in the service planning and delivery to children and youth that is emotionally supportive, socially stimulating, and conducive to learning and development in a cross-cultural context. The CCS's goal will be to create opportunities for young people to learn and grow yet remain connected to their Innu culture, and guide staff to fulfill the best interests of the Innu Child in care.*

**Qualifications:**

- A degree in Social Work and eligibility for registration with the Newfoundland and Labrador Association of Social Workers OR a degree in the Social Sciences combined with clinical and/or Child and Youth Care experience
- Knowledge of current evidence-based therapeutic approaches to psychosocial assessment intervention/ treatment plan development, implementation and evaluation of treatment
- Thorough knowledge of the provincial child protection legislation is an asset
- An understanding of the role that culture, language, and heritage play in an Indigenous child remaining connected to the community
- Updated Certificate of Conduct that is satisfactory to the employer
- Updated Vulnerable Sector Check that is satisfactory to the employer
- A Children, Seniors and Social Development (CSSD) Child Protection Record Check indicating a clear record
- Ability to work flexible hours
- Ability to travel when necessary
