

SOCIAL WORKERS IN PRIVATE PRACTICE

DID YOU KNOW? Social workers are employed in private practice:

- Providing individual, couple, family and group therapy
- Completing assessments such as child, custody and access, parenting, and adoption reports
- Providing leadership and consultation in organizational development and evaluation
- Facilitating community dialogue, community consultation and development
- Engaging in research
- Facilitating program development and design
- Conducting substance abuse assessments and return to work recommendations
- Facilitating conflict resolution, mediation and collaborative problem solving processes
- Working collaboratively with Employee Assistance Programs and facilitating referrals to other agencies when required
- Providing training and education for other professionals, community members and organizational staff
- Providing case consultation
- Providing training in Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) and responding onsite to critical incidents and emergencies
